What if I have a special needs dog?

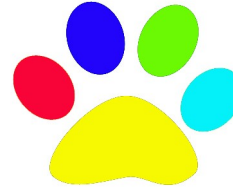
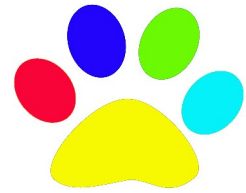
